
The funding is designated for the addition of paved shoulders between Savany Hunt Creek Road (S-86) and Old Sandy Run Road (S-31), as included on South Carolina DOT's Long Range Transportation Plan's Financially Viable Corridor Safety Projects.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars because it will improve vehicular safety on this roadway. This two-lane road accommodates approximately 5,500 vehicles daily and has been the site of multiple crashes in recent years. The addition of a paved shoulder will increase safety, and provide additional space to allow vehicles involved in collisions as well as emergency vehicles to go to mitigate traffic congestion and reduce the risk of injury to those involved in a collision or any emergency workers on the scene.
