SC-06 Congressional District



The project proposed in this request would include the addition of left and right turn lanes on two approaches.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars and would enable traffic to flow more freely and potentially reduce the frequency of collisions, as this location has had multiple crashes in recent years.
