2	(a) In General.—No Federal funds made available
3	to the Department of State or any other department or

8	(2) for any other effort that seeks to label
9	speech or expression as mal-, mis-, or dis-informa-

11	(3) to make any voluntary contributions to the

8	(3) shall not be considered arrears to be repaid
9	to the United Nations or any entity of the United
10	Nations.
