## A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to award grants to promote the domestic hardwood industry, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hardwood Products
- 5 Access and Development Program Act".

1	SEC. 2. HARDWOOD PRODUCTS ACCESS AND DEVELOP-
2	MENT PROGRAM.
3	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Agriculture (in
4	this section referred to as the "Secretary") may award
5	grants, on a competitive basis, to eligible entities to pro-
6	mote the domestic hardwood industry through the fol-
7	lowing activities:
8	(1) Research related to the low carbon foot-
9	print, carbon storage capacity, and resource sustain-
10	ability of domestically produced hardwood products.
11	(2) Promotion of research and education related
12	to domestically produced hardwood products.
13	(3) Promotion of the low carbon footprint, car-
14	bon storage capacity, and resource sustainability of
15	the domestic hardwood industry.
16	(4) Market promotion of domestically produced
17	hardwood products.
18	(5) Consumer market research related to do-
19	mestically produced hardwood products.
20	(6) Demonstration projects demonstrating the
21	natural qualities, low carbon footprint, carbon stor-
22	age capacity, and resource sustainability of domesti-
23	cally harvested hardwood and domestically produced
24	hardwood products.

1	(b) Eligible Entities.—An entity is eligible to re-
2	ceive a grant under subsection (a) if such entity is 1 of
3	the following:
4	(1) A State.
5	(2) A nonprofit organization representing the
6	domestic hardwood products industry.
7	(3) An institution of higher education (as de-
8	fined in section 101 of the Higher Education Act of
9	1965 (20 U.S.C. 1001)).
10	(4) A nonprofit research institution.
11	(c) APPLICATIONS.—To receive a grant under sub-
12	section (a), an eligible entity shall submit to the Secretary
13	an application at such time, in such manner, and con-
14	taining such information as the Secretary may require, in-
15	cluding—
16	(1) a description of the activities to be sup-
17	ported using the grant funds;
18	(2) a description of the goals that the eligible
19	entity intends to achieve as a result of supporting
20	such activities; and
21	(3) an estimate of the increase in hardwood
22	production or consumer awareness that the eligible
23	entity anticipates will occur as a result of supporting
24	such activities.

- 1 (d) REGULATIONS.—The Secretary shall promulgate
- 2 such regulations as are necessary to carry out this section.
- 3 (e) No Preemption of State or Tribal Laws.—
- 4 Nothing in this section shall be construed to preempt any
- 5 law (including a law regarding liability) of a State or In-
- 6 dian Tribe (as defined in section 4 of the Indian Self-De-
- 7 termination and Education Assistance Act (25 U.S.C.
- 8 5304)).
- 9 (f) Domestically Produced Hardwood Prod-
- 10 UCT DEFINED.—The term "domestically produced hard-
- 11 wood product" means a domestically produced product
- 12 that is 90 percent by volume domestically sourced hard-
- 13 wood material.
- 14 (g) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
- 15 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
- 16 \$5,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2024 through 2029.
