3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
This Act may be cited as the "State Immigration En-

6 SEC. 2. STATE ENFORCEMENT OF IMMIGRATION LAWS.
7 States, or political subdivisions of States, may enact,
8 implement and enforce criminal penalties that penalize the
9 same conduct that is prohibited in the criminal provisions

- 1 of immigration laws (as defined in section 101(a)(17) of
- 2 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 3 1101(a)(17)), as long as the criminal penalties do not ex-
- 4 ceed the relevant Federal criminal penalties (without re-
- 5 gard to ancillary issues such as the availability of proba-
- 6 tion or pardon). States, or political subdivisions of States,
- 7 may enact, implement and enforce civil penalties that pe-
- 8 nalize the same conduct that is prohibited in the civil pro-
- 9 visions of immigration laws (as defined in such section
- 10 101(a)(17)), as long as the civil penalties do not exceed
- 11 the relevant Federal civil penalties.
