Dear Chair McCollum and Ranking Member Calvert:

We write to respectfully request that the Defense Subcommittee fund the Department of Defense (DoD) STARBASE Program at \$46 million for Fiscal Year 2022. This would represent a \$5 million increase in total enacted FY21 funding. This level of funding would allow DoD to launch approximately 10 new programs.

DoD STARBASE is an effective DoD outreach and STEM education awareness program for elementary and secondary school students. It provides 25 hours of outstanding STEM instruction, along with hands-on after school STEM activities. Students learn the importance of STEM skills in real world situations and develop essential math and science fundamentals, while fostering positive relationships between the military bases and local communities. Since its inception in 1993, DoD STARBASE has served over 1.4 million students from 33 states and territories, in more than 450 school districts.

Strong evidence-based evaluations of program participants show significant improvement in the students' understanding, interest, and ability in math and science, which has led to increased enthusiasm in pursuing STEM education. In 2019, knowledge scores of chemistry, engineering, math, physics and technology increased on average by 26.6% for all students, while favorability scores of math and science showed clear improvement. In addition, studies performed by Wilder Research on STARBASE Minnesota and by the University of New Mexico at STARBASE La Luz show that the program has potential long term benefits, increasing both high school graduation rates and college enrollment. Furthermore, STARBASE curricula are designed to reach students at the fifth-grade level that are underrepresented in critical areas of study and careers.

Nationwide, the program is one of the most cost-effective programs across the federal government, costing an average of only \$301 per student in 2019.

Despite the unprecedented global pandemic response during the 2020 school year, DoD STARBASE provided STEM engagement opportunities to 56,814 students in 1,189 schools and 409 school districts, while employing 372 personnel. An additional 41,491 students participated in supplemental programs during the school year.

Nationwide, DoD STARBASE locations documented 6,685 volunteers who contributed a total of 86,761 hours to the program valued at \$2,164,556, demonstrating the strong community support for the DoD STARBASE program.

DoD plans to approve the start-up of as many as 6 new STARBASE programs in 2021. More than a dozen additional locations remain on the waiting list for a DoD STARBASE program.

The program's volunteer support, and the robust demand for new programs in spite of funding uncertainty, are a testament to broad community support for the STARBASE program. With its national reach and broad record of success, STARBASE is a key tool in the DoD's ongoing national effort intended to close the STEM achievement gap with other nations, thus reinforcing our long-term security and prosperity. The program is a key tool in bolstering relationships between the DoD and local communities, through assured access to military installations while fostering awareness of military culture.

We therefore ask that the STARBASE receive your full support, and thank you for your past support of the program.
